Our colleague **Joe McGowan** lives in the flooding area and sent along this report, along with the two attached photos:

I'm happy to say we have had NO problem at all. Our house is up on a ridge, so the high ground has kept us safe. We had probably 10-12 inches of rain during the 4 days... But, just 3 miles north of us on U.S. 287, you can make a right turn onto Dillon Road. Some people were on the stretch, just a couple hundred yards east of 287, when the road gave way and plunged 3 vehicles into the water. A culvert under the road was eaten away by raging water in Rock Creek. All people were rescued. Just yesterday, Babette and I drove up that way and also to Erie airport where I took flying lessons and fields are full of water. I will separately send you a pic of that roadway that caved in. On Sunday one pickup was still in the water, as you will see. Today was nice and sunny and things around us are drying out. But there are still a number of people unaccounted for and many homes destroyed.
